

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy contains information on the processing of personal data in connection with the use of the website of the Polish Congress of Mechanics and the Conference on Computational Methods of Mechanics

The Privacy Policy contains information required by the provisions of Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter: the GDPR).

The Privacy Policy also sets out certain terms and conditions for the use of the website and the services available through it.

The information clauses relating to the processing of personal data are grouped according to the use of the website by the user concerned:

1. Visiting and browsing websites.
2. Creating and holding an account on the website.
3. Registration and participation in the Polish Congress of Mechanics and the Conference on Computational Methods of Mechanics.
4. Newsletters and alerts.
5. Information on your rights.

Data processed in connection with visiting and browsing the Event website/website

- a. Data: IP addresses, cookies and similar data about user activity or devices.

We process data for the purposes of:
 - i. enabling the use of the service,
 - ii. monitoring fraud,
 - iii. informing users about the activities of the Polish Society of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics and the Polish Society for Computational Methods of Mechanics,
 - iv. providing advertising space, to conduct marketing, to match content and advertising to users' interests,
 - v. statistics, quality and efficiency measurements,
 - vi. the handling of complaints and the provision of security for claims.
- c. The basis for processing is the necessity for the aforementioned purposes, which arise from the legitimate interests of the joint controllers or third parties.
- d. Legitimate interests consist in constantly improving the quality, accessibility and number of visitors to the website or services available through the website, including free of charge, and in increasing the attractiveness of the advertising space for both advertisers and advertising recipients.
- e. The Joint Controllers may disclose data to other recipients only at the request of entities authorised to do so by law or when it is necessary for the aforementioned purposes, e.g. entities providing hosting, IT service or sale or support of sale of advertising space on our websites.
- f. The joint controllers shall only retain the data for such time as is necessary to fulfil the aforementioned purposes, and no longer than until you object to the processing.

2. Data processed in connection with the creation and maintenance of an account on the website

- a. Details: full name, company/institution/organisation/editorial office/university name, academic or professional title/degree, association/association membership, workplace name, official position, student, landline, mobile, city, postcode, province, street, country,

login details (e-mail). For some services also a photograph. In the event that the services available through the account require processing of data other than the data processed in connection with the account itself, the information in this Privacy Policy on processing in connection with the service in question will also apply to such processing.

- b. The co-controllers of the data are: the Polish Society for Theoretical and Applied Mechanics; and the Polish Society for Computer Methods of Mechanics. Contact details: PTMTS; Al. Armii Ludowej 16, p. 650 00-637 Warsaw; phone: 664-099-345; e-mail: biuro@ptmts.org.pl .
- c. We process data for the purposes of:
 - i. enabling the use of the site and the services available through it, in particular through the use of a single Internet platform (without the need for separate logins, re-saving of data when using different services),
 - ii. verifying your identity for the purposes of monitoring abuse or verifying your eligibility to receive certain content or services,
 - iii. reporting on the activities of the joint controllers,
 - iv. marketing, matching content and advertising to membership of the respective Association/Association,
 - v. statistics, quality and efficiency measurements,
 - vi. handling of claims and security of claims.
- d. The processing is based on the necessity for the aforementioned purposes, which arise from the legitimate interests of the Joint Controllers. For certain services, data or types of processing, the user is asked separately to confirm their consent. In such cases, the data subject's consent is the basis for processing.
- e. The legitimate interests are to continuously improve the quality, accessibility and number of visitors to the sites or services available through our sites, including free of charge, to increase the attractiveness of the advertising space for both advertisers and advertising recipients, and to provide users with a single online platform with access to multiple services.
- f. The Joint Controllers may disclose data to other recipients only at the request of entities authorized to do so by law or when it is necessary for the above purposes, e.g. entities providing hosting, IT service or sale or support of sale of advertising space.
- g. The joint controllers shall only retain the data for such time as is necessary to fulfil the aforementioned purposes, and no longer than until you object to the processing.

Data processed in connection with registration or participation in the event Polish Congress of Mechanics and the Conference on Computational Methods of Mechanics

- a. Data: name and surname, e-mail address, name of company/institution/organisation/editorial office/university, academic or professional title/degree, association/association membership, workplace, job title, student, country, postcode, city, province, landline, mobile, login data (e-mail address and password). For some services also a photograph.
- b. The co-controllers of the data are the Polish Society for Theoretical and Applied Mechanics and the Polish Society for Computer Methods of Mechanics. Contact details: PTMTS; Al. Armii Ludowej 16, p. 650 00-637 Warsaw; phone: 664-099-345; e-mail: biuro@ptmts.org.pl .
- c. Data will be processed for the purposes of:
 - i. registering for the Event and creating an individual account in the registration system, which will allow changing participant data and access to other services provided by the Co-organisers,
 - ii. verification of identity when attending the meeting (for example, when logging in and participating in the interactive online broadcast, entering the premises where the event will take place, printing and issuing the relevant badge),
 - iii. additional identity verification when entering events or restricted areas (Premium area/VIP area, etc.),

- iv. allowing meetings to be arranged between registered participants of an event using a dedicated communicator for mobile devices (available as an additional service),
- v. marketing of services and communication by the co-organisers with the participant, in the form of written correspondence, electronic correspondence or using telecommunication devices (telephones, SMS),
- vi. sharing data with co-organisers, partners and sponsors of the event in order to enable them to communicate with the participant or to market their services – in the form of written correspondence, electronic correspondence or through the use of telecommunication devices (e.g. phone calls, text messages); data recipients as mentioned above will be published and updated on the relevant event pages or in information materials on a regular basis.
- vii. statistics, quality and efficiency measurements,
- viii. handling of claims and security of claims.
- d. The basis for the processing of the data is the necessity for the aforementioned purposes, which arise from the legitimate interests of the Joint Controllers.
- e. Legitimate interests are to continually improve the quality, increase the accessibility of events and the number of participants, provide opportunities for participants to communicate with each other, provide sponsors and partners with information about event participants, including enabling a wide range of people to participate, information about the activities of co-organisers, and to increase the attractiveness of advertising space for both advertisers and advertising recipients.
- f. The Joint Controllers may disclose data to other recipients only at the request of entities entitled to do so by law or when it is necessary for the above purposes, e.g. to organisers, partners and sponsors of the event; lists of such data recipients will be published and updated on an ongoing basis on relevant event pages or in information materials.
- g. The joint controllers shall only retain the data for such time as is necessary to fulfil the aforementioned purposes, and no longer than until you object to the processing.

4 Data processed in connection with the ordering of newsletters and/or alerts

- a. Data: only the email address, the name of the workplace (if the user does not provide other data) can be processed in connection with the newsletter order. In the case of the alert service, the creation of an account will be required, including the provision of additional data confirming the possibility of receiving content targeted to specific industries or specialties - in such cases, the information in sec. 2 of this Privacy Policy on the processing in connection with the creation and holding of an account will also apply in such cases.
- b. The co-controllers of the data are the Polish Society of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics; e-mail: office@ptmts.org.pl and the Polish Society for Computational Methods of Mechanics; e-mail: towarzystwo@ptmkm.pl.
- c. Data will be processed for the purposes of:
 - i. sending you requested newsletters and/or alerts; to verify your eligibility to receive certain content or services,
 - ii. marketing of services and communication by Co-organizers Polish Society of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics and Polish Society of Computational Methods of Mechanics with users of the newsletter and/or alerts,
 - iii. statistics, quality and efficiency measurements,
 - iv. handling of claims and security of claims.
- d. The basis for processing the data is the necessity for the aforementioned purposes, which arise from the legitimate interests of the Joint Controllers.
- e. Legitimate interests are to continuously improve the quality, accessibility and attractiveness of newsletters, alerts and other services of the Co-organisers, to increase the number of subscribed newsletters, and to increase the attractiveness of the advertising space for both advertisers and advertising recipients.

- f. The Joint Controllers may disclose the data to other recipients only at the request of entities authorised to do so by law or when it is necessary to achieve the aforementioned purposes, e.g. to entities providing hosting, IT service or sale or support of sale of advertising space on the website.
- g. The joint controllers shall only retain the data for such time as is necessary to fulfil the aforementioned purposes, and no longer than until you object to the processing.

5. Information on your rights

In relation to the processing of personal data, the user (data subject) has the following rights:

- a. the right to request access to data,
- b. the right to request rectification of data;
- c. the right to ask for the data to be deleted,
- d. the right to request data portability,
- e. the right to ask for the restriction of data processing,
- f. the right not to be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling,
- g. the right to object to the processing of personal data,
- h. the right to lodge a complaint concerning the processing of personal data with the competent supervisory authority.
